Banikanni Secondary School. I am fatherless. My father died when I was in 6th grade in primary school. I live with my mother, my grandmother, my big sister and her daughter. My mother sells millet porridge. My mother cannot afford to pay for the family needs. When I passed to 8th grade with 15.53 average; my aunt suggested to my mother to enroll me at the APEED so that I would have the chance to continue and complete my studies. Since 2019 I have been supported by the APEED. I am happy to have the APEED support. My dream is to pass my Baccalaureate exam next year with a very good average to obtain a medicine scholarship.

Little story of Chabi

(Chabi is the name given to the second boy of the family in Bariba, a language of Northern Benin) My name is Chabi. I am 15 years old. I am student in 9th grade at Titirou secondary school. I am a fatherless. I have an older brother and a little sister. We live with our mother. Our mother is a seamstress. After my dad died, my uncles brought us to the village where I no longer went to school. I lost a school year at home. One day, my mother left the village with us and we returned to Parakou. But we had nothing. It was my mom's friends who gave us a room. Everything was difficult for us even to eat. It was my classroom I heard about the APEED and enrolled myself. I am happy with the APEED for what it does for me. My mother is happy too. I promise to work hard in class.

As a prelude to the 2023-2024 school year scheduled for September 18th, 2023, we celebrated the APEED Annual Day on Saturday September 16th, 2023.
